CMS evaluates and rates the percentage of female plan members aged 50-74 who had a mammogram during the past two years. To increase your percentage, we can counsel patients in conjunction with other SIP programs or individually based on your population needs.

## What can we do?-

- Inquire when (or if) female patients ages 50-74 years old have had a mammogram and address the possible barriers to receiving this service.
- Address any questions and concerns related to medication use and cancer prevention.
- · Encourage patients to have an annual wellness visit.
- Confirm patient is currently being seen by a primary care provider and taking all medications as directed.

Establishing themselves as a caring member of the patient's health care team, our pharmacists know how to address the need for a mammogram with facts and sensitivity. Where needed, our pharmacists will also follow up with the provider to make sure the patient has received the mammogram.
